Here's a quick collection of some creepy sounds to scare the kids with on Halloween night! You may even find a few Voices to use in some of your music. Following is a list with short descriptions of the Voices. Happy Haunting!

1	Graveyard	Howling wind and driving rain set the backdrop for this pad. Use Knobs 1, 2, & 3 to adjust levels of the pad, wind, and rain.	9	Phantom	Play this organ, and you too can be the Phantom!
2	Scream 88	An unsettling, spooky vocal sound. Very velocity sensitive.	10	Clavimorgue	A creepy clav, with a rather unique tone. Don't miss the bass.
3	Franky's Sad	Inspired by the violins in some of the old Frankenstein movies (not to mention "Young Frankenstein")!	11	DeathStrings	
4	Chiller	An other-worldly pad.	12	Witches'Brew	The boiling cauldrons bubble in the background as the witches howl.
5	Terror	A deep, layered sound for "Terror Tracks".	13	CreaturFeatr	"Creature Feature" was inspired by an old late Saturday night sci-fi/horror movie slot by the same name.
6	The Crypt	Voices from The Beyond.	14	EX BlueGhoul	The "Blue Ghoul" howls with some interesting filter resonance.
7	Full Moon	It's a windy night with a full moon, and the ghosts are out! Play various single notes for best effect.	15	The Haunting	This is an FX Voice modeled after the banging noise heard in the original old movie "The Haunting".
8	Black Cat	Just your basic synth cat.	16	Creep Sweep	Play and hold a single deep bass note for a slow, growling, filter sweep backdrop.

Note: A number of the Voices in Halloween Ghoul make use of the EX5's FDSP synthesis, which to a degree, makes this an "EX5 only" release.
